



- ▶ GEN. 7: 1-3 Animaux Purs + Impurs (avant la Loi)

- ▶ GEN. 1: 26 Fish – Fowl – Cattle – Creeping thing
- ▶ GEN. 7: 1-3 Clean + Unclean animals (before the Law)

- ▶ RAMPER - IMPUR
 - ▶ VENTRE (Gakhon) = CENTRE D'AFFECTION; POUSSIÈRE DE LA TERRE
 - ▶ JAMBES POUR SAUTER (Nathar) = AVANCER EN DIEU
 - ▶ Gen. 3: 15; Psa. 119: 25; 2 Cor. 10: 5; Col. 3: 1,3

- ▶ CREEP - IMPURE
 - ▶ BELLY (Gakhon) = DESIRES, AFFECTIONS; DUST OF THE GROUND
 - ▶ LEGS TO LEAP (Nathar) = MOVING FORWARD WITH GOD
 - ▶ Gen. 3: 15; Psa. 119: 25; 2 Cor. 10: 5; Col. 3: 1,3



LA LOI EN APPLICATION

APPLYING THE LAW

- ▶ ÊTRE PUR OU IMPUR: CE QUI SORT, PAS CE QUI ENTRE
- ▶ MANGER ANIMAUX PURS: JÉSUS, AGNEAU DE DIEU
- ▶ CHAIR = BÉATITUDES; SANG = INCORPORER SES PRINCIPES
- ▶ NE PAS MANGER CE QUI EST IMPUR
- ▶ MARC 7: 18-19; MATTH. 23: 24,26; EPH. 5: 18-19; JEA. 6: 54; 6: 63; HEB. 13: 9; EPH. 4: 11: 24

- ▶ BEING PURE OR IMPURE: WHAT COMES OUT, NOT WHAT COMES IN
- ▶ EATING CLEAN: JESUS, LAMB OF GOD
- ▶ HIS FLESH = BEATITUDES; HIS BLOOD = EMBODY HIS PRINCIPLES
- ▶ DO NOT EAT UNCLEAN THING

LOIS DES IMPURETÉS

LAWS OF UNCLEANNESS

- ▶ LEV. 15: 16 = zera shekabah : semence sur une couche
- ▶ Impur: tame = être ou devenir impur 1) sexuellement 2) dans un sens religieux ; Souiller sexuellement ; Dans un sens religieux ; Déclarer impur ; Profaner (le nom de Dieu).
- ▶ V. 31
- ▶ 1 Cor. 6: 18-20; 2 Cor. 7: 1
- ▶ LEV. 15: 16 = zera shekabah : seed in the act of lying
- ▶ Unclean – tame = to be or become unclean, become impure (sexually, religiously, ceremonially; to defile oneself, be regarded as unclean; to profane God's name.

- ▶ 1 Cor. 6: 18-20; 2 Cor. 7: 1

- ▶ Rêveries = Eupniazomai : Métaphorique, être trompé par des images sensuelles et emmené vers une conduite impie. Souillent : Souiller, polluer, tacher, contaminer, infecter ; souillé par les péchés.
- ▶ PROV. 7: 6 -22 ; 6: 23-30;
- ▶ ROM. 13: 13; SONG. 8: 8-10; ROM. 1: 26
- ▶ JUDE 7-8; 10, 16-25
- ▶ filthy dreamers = Eupniazomai = Metaph. To be beguiled with sensual images and carried away to an impious course of conduct. Defile = To dye with another colour, to stain; to defile, pollute, contaminate, defile with sins

LEVITICUS 22: 4

- ▶ *Lév. 22 : 4 Tout homme de la race d'Aaron, qui aura la lèpre ou une gonorrhée, ne mangera point des choses saintes jusqu'à ce qu'il soit pur. Il en sera de même pour celui qui touchera une personne souillée par le contact d'un cadavre, pour celui qui aura une pollution.*
- ▶ *Lev. 22 : 4 What man soever of the seed of Aaron is a leper, or hath a running issue; he shall not eat of the holy things, until he be clean. And whoso toucheth any thing that is unclean by the dead, or a man whose seed goeth from him;*
